A total of 290 Myson Low Surface Temperature (LST) radiators will help to ensure the safety of residents of Beechwood, May Place, Newcastle-Under-Lyme, a new, purpose built complex of 37 two-bedroom and 28 one-bedroom apartments, offering supported living from The Wrekin Housing Trust's ShireLiving brand.

The Myson LSTs were selected for their competitive price and high quality of manufacture. Robust outer casings prevent the surface temperature from exceeding 43°C and the smooth, rounded-edge design helps to prevent injury in the event of a fall. The casing covers all pipework, and clips securely to the wall for safety, but is easily removed for cleaning and maintenance. TRVs allow the temperature to be easily adjusted to suit individuals' needs.

As well as 65 affordable rented apartments, Beechwood will also have a residents' lounge and coffee bar, onsite community restaurant, laundry room and a guest apartment for friends and relatives.

Hydro Mechanical specified Myson LSTs because they offered good value for money with a robust, curved design that provides warmth for residents with maximum safety. They meet NHS and HSE guidelines for a maximum radiator surface temperature of 43°C. As well as being energy efficient, they are aesthetically pleasing; helping to create a comfortable living space.
